(SOON)

EXAMPLE: THE BOY ALREADY WENT HOME.

ALL READY

PROOF: NOT READY

(NOT READY)

EXAMPLE: IS EVERYONE ALL READY TO GO?

SHOULD'VE

PROOF: SHOULD HAVE

(SHOULD HAVE)

EXAMPLE: I SHOULD'VE WORN BLUE.

ME/I

PROOF: BREAK THEM UP

(I TALKED)

EXAMPLE: ~~MY MOM AND I TALKED ABOUT MY BROTHER~~

(ABOUT ME)

AND ME.

**LOSE**

PROOF: FIND, WIN  
(FIND)

EXAMPLE: DID SHE LOSE HER PEN?

**LOOSE**

PROOF: TIGHT

EXAMPLE: THE DOORKNOB IS LOOSE.  
(TIGHT)

# AFFECT

PROOF: A VERB (I \_\_\_\_, YOU \_\_\_\_, HE \_\_S)

(I AFFECT, YOU AFFECT, HE AFFECTS)

EXAMPLE: THE NEW LAW WILL AFFECT EVERYONE.

# EFFECT

PROOF: A NOUN (A/AN \_\_\_\_, THE \_\_\_\_, SAME \_\_S)

(AN EFFECT, THE EFFECT, SAME EFFECTS)

EXAMPLE: WEATHER HAS AN EFFECT ON MOODS.





# LESS

PROOF: CAN YOU COUNT THEM? NO.

(UNCOUNTABLE)

EXAMPLE: I HAVE LESS CLOTHES THAN I USED TO.



# FEWER

PROOF: COUNTABLE? YES.

(COUNTABLE)

EXAMPLE: I HAVE FEWER RINGS ON THAN YOU.

PROOF: THEY ARE

(THEY ARE)

EXAMPLE: THEY'RE MY FRIENDS!

THERE

PROOF: HERE

(HERE)

EXAMPLE: PUT YOUR HAT THERE.
